UNINSURED/UNDERINSURED MOTORISTS SELECTION FORM—ILLINOIS

UNINSURED/UNDERINSURED MOTORISTS BODILY INJURY COVERAGE

Illinois Insurance Code requires that all automobile liability policies contain uninsured motorists bodily injury coverage at limits equal to the Illinois Vehicle Code. You may select limits equal to your bodily injury limits or lower limits, but not less than \$20,000 per person/\$40,000 per occurrence split limits or \$40,000 single limit.

Uninsured motorists coverage pays for bodily injury losses to you and your passenger as a result of an accident with a driver who has no liability protection and is legally responsible for the injuries. This includes a hit-and-run vehicle whose owner and operator can not be identified.

You may also select underinsured motorist coverage that pays for bodily injury losses to you and your passengers as a result of an accident with a driver who has liability protection with limits that are lower than the underinsured motorists limits you have selected, and that person is legally responsible for your injuries. Underinsured motorists coverage may be selected at limits equal to your bodily injury limits or lower limits, but not less than \$20,000 per person/\$40,000 per occurrence split limits or \$40,000 single limit.

UNINSURED MOTORISTS PROPERTY DAMAGE COVERAGE

Uninsured motorists property damage coverage provides protection for property damage caused by an uninsured motorist. This coverage is available only for private passenger automobiles or recreational motor vehicles that are designed for use on public highways for which you have not purchased collision coverage. The limit of coverage is the actual cash value of the insured motor vehicle or \$15,000, whichever is less, subject to a \$250. deductible per insured vehicle as a result of any one accident.
