

**NOTICE TO POLICYHOLDERS**

**KENTUCKY LAW ON UNINSURED MOTORIST COVERAGE**

Kentucky law provides that all motor vehicle liability insurance policies shall contain insurance, "for the protection of persons insured thereunder who are legally entitled to recover damages from owners or operators of uninsured motor vehicles because of bodily injury, sickness or disease, including death, resulting therefrom." It further provides that you have the right to reject in writing such coverage. Such uninsured motorist coverage has been included in your policy. If you desire to reject such coverage, sign the rejection form set forth below and specify thereon the name of the insurance company and the policy number. Send this rejection form to the company and you will receive a return premium credit on your policy of approximately \$ \_\_\_\_\_.
